The Iota Omega Chapter began issuing scholarships to the Tidewater community in 1924, coinciding with National Vocational Guidance Week. As the only Tidewater-based graduate chapter of the sorority, high school students in Norfolk, Portsmouth and Newport News, Virginia benefitted from this form of financial support. With the development of other graduate chapters in sister cities, Iota Omega concentrated its efforts within Booker T. Washington High School, the only African American high school in the city until school desegregation. Currently, this scholarship is offered to students from all five public Norfolk high schools.

## **Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® Iota Omega Chapter Norfolk High School Scholarship Criteria**

- 1. The applicant must be a female high school student attending a Norfolk public school.**
- 2. The applicant must be a resident of Norfolk, Virginia.**
- 3. The applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and submit an official high school transcript with appropriate endorsements and/or signatures.**
- 4. The applicant must have an acceptance letter from the college or university of intent.**
- 5. The applicant must submit a completed application with a parent or guardian signature.**
- 6. The applicant must complete the essay requirement.**
- 7. The applicant must have two letters of recommendation from a teacher, administrator, or community representative (no family members).**
- 8. The applicant must enroll as a full-time student at a four-year college or university.**
- 9. The applicant must not complete an application for the Vivian Carter Mason Community Scholarship Award.**

**Members of Iota Omega Chapter shall recuse themselves from the application process if a relative applies.**
