Lillian Brinkley has dedicated over 50 years to education as a teacher, elementary school principal, and educational consultant. She was hand-selected to lead Virginia's first model school, Willard Model School, where she played a pivotal role in significantly improving students' standardized test scores. In recognition of her exceptional leadership, she was named a National Distinguished Principal by the U.S. Department of Education in 1985. Her impact on education and the community was further honored in 2012 when the city of Norfolk designated February 14 as Lillian Brinkley Day.

A native of Suffolk, Virginia, Ms. Brinkley was initiated into the Alpha Epsilon chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® at Virginia State University in 1959. A dedicated member, she has held several offices within the Iota Omega Chapter and recently celebrated 65 years of service in the sorority.
